

**SECOND ADDENDUM TO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE
GEOLOGICAL, MINING AND METALLURGICAL INSTITUTE OF THE ENERGY AND MINES
SECTOR OF THE REPUBLIC OF PERU (INGEMMET) AND THE FEDERAL INSTITUTE OF
GEOSCIENCES AND NATURAL RESOURCES OF THE GERMAN FEDERAL REPUBLIC (BGR)**

This document is the second ADDENDUM to a Memorandum of Understanding on Geoscientific Cooperation entered into by the **Geological, Mining and Metallurgical Institute**, hereinafter "**INGEMMET**", specialized public institution of the Ministry of Energy and Mines of the Republic of Peru, having registered office at Av. Canada 1470, San Borja – Lima 41, Peru, duly represented by the Executive President **Mr. Víctor Manuel Díaz Yosa**.

And the other part, the **Federal Institute of Geosciences and Natural Resources**, hereinafter referred to as "**BGR**", geoscientific and technological public organization, having registered office at Bundesanstalt für Geowissenschaften und Rohstoffe, Stilleweg 2, 30655, Hannover, Germany, duly represented by Professor Dr. **RALPH WATZEL**, president of BGR, under the following terms and conditions:

ARTICLE ONE: RECITALS

- 1.1 On the 15th November 2017 a second Addendum to the Memorandum of Understanding on Geoscientific Cooperation between the Geological, Mining and Metallurgical Institute, (**INGEMMET**) and the Federal Institute of Geosciences and Natural Resources (**BGR**) is entered with the purpose to cooperate and exchange information as well as technical and scientific personnel through joint studies and research of mutual interest. The Parties agree to carry out activities in the geoscientific fields based on equality, reciprocity and mutual benefit. The main purpose is to enable reciprocal channels for the transmission of knowledge and information as well as facilitate collaboration on scientific research.
- 1.2 On the 16th May 2019 a second Addendum to the Memorandum of Understanding on Geoscientific Cooperation between **INGEMMET** and **BGR** is entered, in which, a "**Evaluation of the potential of zinc and lead deposits, regarding new discovered prospects and upcoming project** " Cooperation Project is defined, for a period of two years to 2021.
- 1.3 During 2020, fieldwork trips were scheduled that could not be completed due to the **SARS-coV-2** pandemic, which has affected our nations, extending the validity of the memorandum until 30th November 2022.

SECOND ARTICLE: PURPOSE

Both parties agree:

To extend the period of the "**Evaluation of the potential of zinc and lead deposits, regarding new discovered prospects and upcoming project**" Cooperation Project from 16th May 2021 to 30th November 2022.

From INGEMMET side the responsible personnel will be the Head of the Metallogeny Program and the Director of Mineral and Energy Resources.

THIRD ARTICLE: FINAL CLAUSES

The Parties declare that all the terms and conditions contained in the other articles of the Addendum a Memorandum of Understanding on Geoscientific Cooperation remain in force.

The Parties being in agreement with the contents and scope of this Addendum, it is hereby signed by **INGEMMET** and **BGR**, in two (02) equally authentic copies in English and Spanish.
