VISTOS: La Hoja de Registro y Control N° 07749 de fecha 06 de abril de 2022; el Memorándum N° 419-20222/GRP-100010 de fecha 08 de abril de 2022; y, el Convenio de Cooperación Interinstitucional entre School Day Helsinki, Wholeschools Institute International, Choice Humanitarian y el Gobierno Regional Piura.

CONSIDERANDO:

Que, en concordancia con el artículo 191 de la Constitución Política del Perú, el artículo 8 de la Ley N° 27783, Ley de Bases de la Descentralización, precisa que la autonomía es el derecho y capacidad efectiva de los Gobiernos en sus tres niveles, de normar, regular y administrar los asuntos públicos de su competencia, autonomía sujeta a los parámetros de la Constitución Política;

Que, con fecha 28 de febrero de 2022, de conformidad a la atribución establecida en el literal k del artículo 21 de la Ley N° 27867, esta Gobernación Regional suscribió el Convenio de Cooperación Interinstitucional entre School Day Helsinki, Wholeschools Institute International, Choice Humanitarian y el Gobierno Regional Piura, cuyo objeto es el siguiente: *"Por el presente Convenio de Cooperación Interinstitucional, LAS PARTES manifiestan su voluntad de articular y establecer relaciones de apoyo y cooperación con el objeto de ejecutar e implementar el proyecto denominado "Mejoramiento del Aprendizaje a través del Programa School Day de Finlandia, aplicado en las Instituciones Educativas: Parroquial Santa Rita y Almirante Miguel Grau, de la provincia y distrito de Morropón, II.EE Isolina Baca del distrito de Chulucanas, e II. EE. San Agustín del distrito de La Matanza, el mismo que tiene como objetivo, 4 desarrollar el modelo de bienestar del día escolar en cuatro temas principales: aprendizaje, habilidades sociales y emocionales, relaciones sociales y bienestar". Asimismo, tiene como objetivos específicos los siguientes: "Desarrollar las competencias basadas en las cuatro dimensiones de bienestar que marca el modelo: Habilidades Sociales y Emocionales, Bienestar, Relaciones Sociales y Aprendizaje. Cada una de estas dimensiones cuenta con subcategorías que atienden un total de 18 competencias que se desarrollan a lo largo del ciclo escolar"*;

Que, el artículo 4 de la Ley N° 27867, "Ley Orgánica de Gobiernos Regionales", establece lo siguiente: *"Los gobiernos regionales tienen por finalidad esencial fomentar el desarrollo regional integral sostenible, promoviendo la inversión pública y privada y el empleo y garantizar el ejercicio pleno de los derechos y la igualdad de oportunidades de sus habitantes, de acuerdo con los planes y programas nacionales, regionales y locales de desarrollo"*;

Que, el artículo 6 de la citada ley, prescribe que: *"El desarrollo regional comprende la aplicación coherente y eficaz de las políticas e instrumentos de desarrollo económico social, poblacional, cultural y ambiental, a través de planes, programas y proyectos orientados a generar condiciones que permitan el crecimiento económico armonizado con la dinámica demográfica, el desarrollo social equitativo y la conservación de los recursos naturales y el ambiente en el territorio regional, orientado hacia el ejercicio pleno de los derechos de hombres y mujeres e igualdad de oportunidades"*;

Que, el artículo 9 de la Ley N° 27867, "Ley Orgánica de Gobiernos Regionales" establece cuales son las competencias constitucionales que tienen los gobiernos regionales, señalando entre otras, la siguiente: *"g) Promover y regular actividades y/o servicios en materia de agricultura, pesquería, industria, agroindustria, comercio, turismo, energía, minería, vialidad, comunicaciones, educación, salud y medio ambiente, conforme a Ley". Asimismo, el artículo 10 de la citada Ley regula*



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las competencias exclusivas y compartidas establecidas en la Constitución Política del Perú y la Ley de bases de la Descentralización, señalando en el numeral 2, inciso a), la siguiente competencia compartida: "a) *Educación. Gestión de los servicios educativos de nivel inicial, primaria, secundaria y superior no universitaria, con criterios de interculturalidad orientados a potenciar la formación para el desarrollo*";

Que, en ese orden de motivos, el artículo 47 de la Ley N° 27867, "Ley Orgánica de Gobiernos Regionales" establece las funciones del gobierno regional en materia de educación, cultura, ciencia, tecnología, deporte y recreación, señalando entre otras, las siguientes: "a) *Formular, aprobar, ejecutar, evaluar y administrar las políticas regionales de educación, cultura, ciencia y tecnología, deporte y recreación de la región; (...) q) Fomentar y participar en el diseño, ejecución y evaluación de proyectos de investigación, experimentación e innovación educativa que aporten al desarrollo regional y al mejoramiento de la calidad de servicio educativo; (...)*";

Que, el Texto Único Ordenado de la Ley N° 27444, Ley del Procedimiento Administrativo General, aprobado con Decreto Supremo N° 004-2019-JUS, prescribe: "88.1 Las entidades están facultadas para dar estabilidad a la colaboración interinstitucional mediante conferencias entre entidades vinculadas, convenios de colaboración u otros medios legalmente admisibles; 88.4 Las entidades pueden celebrar convenios con las instituciones del sector privado, siempre que con ello se logre el cumplimiento de su finalidad y no se vulnere normas de orden público";

Que, con Resolución Ejecutiva Regional N° 472-2013/GOBIERNO REGIONAL PIURA-PR de fecha 14 de agosto de 2013, se aprobó la Directiva Regional N° 016-2013/GRP-100010 "Normas y procedimientos para la suscripción de Convenios por parte del Gobierno Regional", y es conforme a ella que se formaliza la aprobación del Convenio de Cooperación Interinstitucional entre School Day Helsinki, Wholeschools Institute International, Choice Humanitarian y el Gobierno Regional Piura;

Que, la presente Resolución Ejecutiva Regional se suscribe en virtud al Principio de Legalidad, por el cual las autoridades administrativas deben actuar con respeto a la Constitución, la Ley y al derecho, dentro de las facultades que le estén atribuidas y de acuerdo con los fines para los que les fueron conferidas; así como al Principio de Buena Fe Procedimental, por lo cual la autoridad administrativa, los administrados, sus representante o abogados y, en general, todos los partícipes del procedimiento, realizan sus respectivos actos procedimentales guiados por el respeto mutuo, la colaboración y la buena fe (...), previstos en el Texto Único Ordenado de la Ley N° 27444, Ley del Procedimiento Administrativo General, aprobado por Decreto Supremo N° 004-2019-JUS;

Con las visaciones de la Oficina Regional de Asesoría Jurídica, Gerencia Regional de Desarrollo Económico, Gerencia Regional de Planeamiento, Presupuesto y Acondicionamiento Territorial, Gerencia General Regional y la Secretaría General del Gobierno Regional Piura;

En uso de las atribuciones conferidas por la Constitución Política del Perú, Ley N° 27783 - Ley de Bases de la Descentralización, Ley N° 27867 - Ley Orgánica de los Gobiernos Regionales y su modificatoria Ley N° 27902, Directiva Regional N° 016-2013/GRP-100010.

INTER-INSTITUTIONAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN SCHOOL DAY HELSINKI, WHOLESCHOOLS INSTITUTE INTERNATIONAL, CHOICE HUMANITARIAN AND THE REGIONAL GOVERNMENT OF PIURA

This is hereby the Interinstitutional Cooperation Agreement entered into by Choice Humanitarian, with address at 20033 SE 416th St. Enumclaw, Washington 98022, USA, and Office in Peru located at Urb. Miraflores-calle las Acacias 160-Q1-It40. - Piura, Peru, duly represented by its Peruvian Director, Mr. Wilmer Cruz La Madrid, who will be referred to as "**CHOICE HUMANITARIAN**"; **THE REGIONAL GOVERNMENT OF PIURA**, with Unique Taxpayer Registry N° 20484004421, with legal address at Av. San Ramón S/N, Urb. San Eduardo - El Chipe, in the District, Province and Department of Piura, duly represented by its Regional Governor, Doctor Servando García Correa, identified with National Identity Card N°41315243, appointed by Resolution N° 3594-2018-JNE of the National Jury of Elections, hereinafter referred to as "**THE REGIONAL GOVERNMENT**"; and, **SCHOOL DAY HELSINKI Ltd**, with address at Fredrikinkatu 47 00100 Helsinki, Finland, duly represented by its Executive Director Mika Kasanen, who shall be referred to as "**SCHOOL DAY**"; **WHOLESCHOOLS INSTITUTE INTERNATIONAL**, with address at Alfredo de Musset 27 Ciudad de México, 11550, México, as the representative of School Day Helsinki Ltd (Business ID FI28630944) in Latin America, whose legal representative is Andrea Denise Ferrari Broggi, will be denominated **WHOLESCHOOLS**; who proceed duly empowered under the following terms and conditions:

CLAUSE ONE: LEGAL BASIS

- Political Constitution of Peru of 1993
- Law No. 27630, Constitutional Reform Law (Chapter XIV, Title IV, Decentralization)
- Law No. 27867, Organic Law of Regional Governments and its amendment: Law No. 27902.
- Law No. 27783, Law on the Bases of Decentralization, as amended.
- Law No. 28411, General Law of the National Budget System.
- Legislative Decree N° 1440, Legislative Decree of the National Budget System.
- Sale Ordered Text of Law No. 27444, General Administrative Procedure Law, approved by Supreme Decree N° 004-2019-JUS.
- Law N° 27806, Law of Transparency and Access to Public Information.
- Public Sector Budget Law for the Fiscal Year
- Civil Code.
- Supreme Decree N° 027-2019-RE, which approves the Regulation of the Decentralized National System of Non-Reimbursable International Cooperation.
- Emergency Decree No. 016-2020. Establishing measures regarding human resources in the public sector.

CLAUSE TWO: BACKGROUND

On February 18, 2021, the Counselor of the Embassy of Finland in Peru, Jorge Fernandez Gates, introduced the representative of the Finnish company School Day via email to evaluate the possibility of working on a cooperation project in education.

On March 15, 2021, representatives of School Day, the Regional Education Directorate and the Regional Management of International Technical Cooperation met through a virtual platform with the purpose of learning about the School Day Wellness model.



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On September 2, 2021, the project proposal "Improvement of Learning through the Finnish School Day Program, applied in the Educational Institutions of the Province of Morropón" was emailed to Choice Humanitarian in order to work on this project in alliance with School Day.

By meeting dated November 10, 2021, Choice Humanitarian confirms its interest in being a co-financier of the project to improve learning through the Finnish School Day Program, applied in the following educational institutions: Parroquial Santa Rita and Almirante Miguel Grau, in the province and district of Morropón, II.EE Isolina Baca in the district of Chulucanas, and II. EE. San Agustín of the district of La Matanza,

On Monday, December 13, the beneficiary educational institutions met on a virtual platform with representatives of School Day and Choice Humanitarian to learn about the project and coordinate actions for its implementation:

- II. EE. Isolina Baca (Chulucanas)
- II. EE. San Agustín (La Matanza)

By means of Multiple Memorandum N° 033-2021/GRP-420000, the Regional Management of Economic Development requested the confirmation of the four prioritized educational institutions to participate in the cooperation project: "Improvement of school learning through the School Day Wellness Model in educational institutions of the Province of Morropón".

By means of OFFICIAL N° 118-2021-GOB.REG.REG.PIURA-DREP-UGEL N° 307, the Principal of the Educational Institution Miguel Grau confirmed the participation in the cooperation project.

By means of OFFICIAL N° 056 - 2021 - GOB-REG.PIURA-DREP-U.E.303-AP-I.E.IBH-D, the Principal of the educational institution Isolina Baca Haz, confirmed its participation in the cooperation project.

By means of OFFICIAL N° 070-2021- DRE-P/ UGEL-CH / NGE-LM /-IE.SA-LM/D, the Principal of the Educational Institution San Agustin, confirmed its participation in the cooperation project. Institución Educativa San Agustín, confirms its participation in the cooperation project.

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CLAUSE THREE: OF THE PARTIES

The **REGIONAL GOVERNMENT OF PIURA** is a legal entity under public law, with political, economic and administrative autonomy in matters within its competence. Its essential purpose is to foster sustainable integral regional development, promoting public and private investment and employment, and guaranteeing the full exercise of the rights and equal opportunities of its inhabitants in accordance with national, regional and local development plans and programs.

CLAUSE FOUR: OBJECTIVES

4.1 General Objective of the Agreement:

By this Inter-institutional Cooperation Agreement, THE PARTIES express their willingness to articulate and establish relations of support and cooperation in order to execute and implement the project called "Improvement of Learning through the Finnish School Day Program, applied in the following educational institutions: Parroquial Santa Rita and Almirante Miguel Grau, in the province and district of Morropón, II.EE Isolina Baca in the district of Chulucanas, and II. EE. San Agustín of the district of La Matanza. The project aims to develop the school day wellness model in four main themes: learning, social and emotional skills, social relations and well-being.



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4.2 Specific Objectives of the Agreement:

Developing competencies based on the four dimensions of wellbeing established by the model: Social and Emotional Skills, Wellness, Social Relationships and Learning. Each of these dimensions has subcategories that address a total of 18 competencies that are developed throughout the school cycle.

CLAUSE FIVE: PROJECT DESCRIPTION

School Day asks students questions about their wellbeing, analyzes the data and provides real-time feedback. The Program highlights what is going well in the classroom and provides easily implementable solutions. From the classroom to the school, students and educators are helped to learn how wellness improves learning outcomes.

School Day wants all students to have a voice and be heard equally and it asks students questions about their wellbeing using emojis appropriate for all age groups, highlighting what is going well in schools and classrooms and provides solutions to the most pressing issues. When students feel good, they learn better.



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Students express how they feel by answering weekly wellness questions in a secure, anonymous application and receive feedback and practical tips for reflection and learning.

Student voice is amplified in actionable data and intervention strategies to improve student wellness and Socio-Emotional Learning (SEL).

The School Day Wellness model covers four main themes: learning, social and emotional skills, social relationships and wellness.

You will have instant data on how your students are feeling and receive weekly highlights with CASEL-aligned discussion topics, intervention strategies, and grade-specific lesson plans.

School Day provides teachers with highlights, intervention strategies and support for concrete discussions for brief weekly check-ins with students. Each month a new CASEL-aligned lesson plan is generated based on the most pressing issues and weaknesses in the classroom.

CLAUSE SIX: SCOPE OF PROJECT EXECUTION

The project will be implemented in the following educational institutions:

CLAUSE SEVEN: TERM OF EFFECTIVENESS

The project is 12 months long. It will start on March 1, 2022 and end on February 28, 2023.

CLAUSE EIGHT: COST OF THE PROJECT AND CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE PARTIES

Each of the parties has valued its counterpart contributions which are summarized in Annex No. 01.

CLAUSE NINE: EXECUTION OF THE PROJECT

Choice Humanitarian, as General Coordinator, will be in charge of the Project execution, and each of the institutions will have a designated Coordinator.

CLAUSE TEN: INSTITUTIONAL COORDINATORS

For the purpose of implementing, adapting, executing and complying with this Inter Institutional Cooperation Agreement, THE PARTIES agree to designate their Coordinators.

For the Regional Government: The Regional Directorate of Education.

For School Day: WholeSchools Institute International, S.A DE C.V, representative in Hispanic America.

For Choice Humanitarian: Director in Peru.





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CLAUSE ELEVEN: PROJECT REPORTS

- 11.1 Choice Humanitarian will send the parties a progress report on the project on a bi-monthly basis.
- 10.4 The General Coordinator of the Project will meet every two months with the coordinators of the institutions to evaluate the progress of the project.

CLAUSE TWELFTH: COMMITMENTS OF THE PARTIES

12.1 Of Choice Humanitarian

1. It will be responsible for the execution and liquidation of the Project.
2. Choice Humanitarian will co-finance the acquisition of the license to School Day, for the development of the project.
3. Choice Humanitarian provides its psychologists team for the project development.
4. It will provide permanent accompaniment, control, support, technical assistance and evaluation to the professionals involved in the project.
5. Choice Humanitarian will coordinate with the institutions the preparation and dissemination of the quarterly Virtual Newsletter on the progress of the project.
6. Communicate to the parties any circumstance or event that affects the normal execution of the activities and/or the fulfillment of the agreements established in this Agreement or that could affect the activities of the project.

12.2 OF THE REGIONAL GOVERNMENT

1. Perform monitoring of project activities in coordination with the parties.
2. The Regional Education Directorate, in coordination with the Morropón Local Education Management Unit (UGEL Morropón), will provide a professional in charge of monthly monitoring and systematization of the project's progress.
3. The Regional Education Directorate assumes the commitment to represent the Regional Government in the Project coordination and to provide the corresponding technical assistance.
4. The Regional Government of Piura, through the Regional Directorate of Education, will disseminate the results and lessons learned from the School Day model.

12.3 SCHOOL DAY & WHOLESCHOOLS INSTITUTE INTERNATIONAL,

1. Make the license of the School Day Program available for the Project execution
2. Create user accounts in School Day Program for the coordinators of Choice Humanitarian for the development of the Project. Choice Humanitarian must provide School Day the institutional email accounts of each user that will participate in the execution/supervision of program.
3. Train IIEE teachers in the use of the School Day application.
4. Provide adequate and timely data-driven support.

- 5. Provide technical support and advice to the project's educational institutions.
 - 6. Process and interpret the data from the surveys applied to the students of the project's educational institutions.
 - 7. Grant a scholarship of US\$2 per beneficiary student towards the cost of the purchase of the license, according to Annex 01.
 - 8. Cooperate in the implementation, supervision, monitoring and evaluation of Project activities in coordination with the parties.
 - 9. Access/users to the platform: School Day will create an account for each user (students, teachers and administrative team including the counselors, coordinators and directors). Each user must provide an email account to create their account (it must be the email account assigned by the educational institution). This information must be delivered by the project coordinators of each educational center. It must include a list indicating the name of each student by group/grade and each teacher by group/grade assigned to provide them with access to the platform. A separate list of the coordination/administrative staff who should have access to the data on the platform, for example counselors and coordinators including those on behalf of Choice Humanitarian, indicating which grade/levels/groups access will be assigned to them.

CLAUSE THIRTEEN: MONITORING AND SUPERVISION

For the purposes of monitoring and supervision, THE PARTIES designate their respective representatives.

For the Regional Government: The Regional Management of International Technical Cooperation

For School Day: WholeSchools Institute International, S.A DE C.V, representative in Spanish America.

For Choice Humanitarian: The Director in Peru

CLAUSE FOURTEEN: ANNEXES

The following Annex is an integral part of this Agreement and is duly signed by THE PARTIES:

- a) Annex N° 1: Project budget.

CLAUSE FIFTEEN: FREE ADHERENCE AND SEVERANCE

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 77°, paragraph 77.3 of the General Administrative Procedure Law - Law No. 27444, THE PARTIES enter into this Agreement freely and in accordance with their competencies; consequently, the agreement may be declared terminated upon prior notice to the other party with thirty (30) working days' notice, after which the free separation shall take effect.



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CLAUSE SIXTEEN: OF MODIFICATIONS

This Agreement may be modified or extended by means of an Addendum or Additional Clause coordinated and subscribed by THE PARTIES, when they deem it convenient and the modifications introduced have the respective legal support.

CLAUSE SEVENTEENTH: DOMICILE AND NOTIFICATIONS

- 17.1 For the effects derived from this Agreement, THE PARTIES establish as their domiciles those indicated in the introductory part of this document.
- 17.2 All documents to be notified or sent between the parties shall be deemed to have been validly executed if they are sent to the addresses indicated in the introductory part of this agreement.
- 17.3 Any change of address during the term of this AGREEMENT shall be notified to the other party, by means of a dated document, to the addresses stated in the introductory part with fifteen (15) working days' notice.

CLAUSE EIGHTEEN: SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

- 18.1 The Parties declare to know the content and scope of each and every one of the Clauses that regulate the present Agreement, committing themselves to respect it according to the rules of good faith and common intention, pointing out that there is no vice or error that could invalidate it.
- 18.2 In the event of any discrepancy or controversy arising from the interpretation or fulfillment of this Agreement, it shall be resolved by direct agreement between the Parties following the rules of Good Faith and Common Intention of the Parties, the latter committing themselves to make their best efforts to achieve a harmonious solution, taking into account the principles inspired by this Agreement.

CLAUSE NINETEEN: JURISDICTION

Without prejudice to what is stated in the previous clause, in the case of requiring the intervention of the Judicial Power, the parties submit to the jurisdiction of the judges and courts of Piura. For which purpose they ratify as their domiciles those stated in the introduction of this Agreement.




