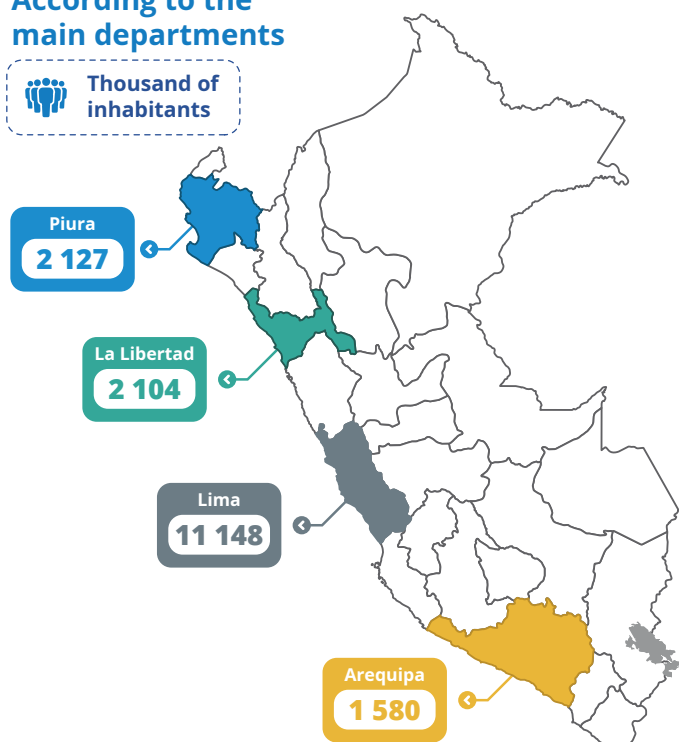

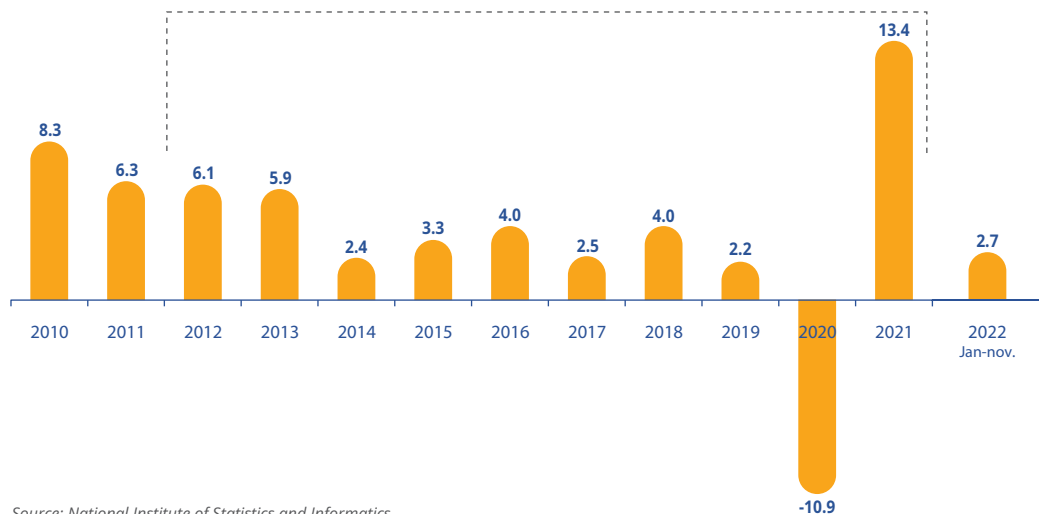

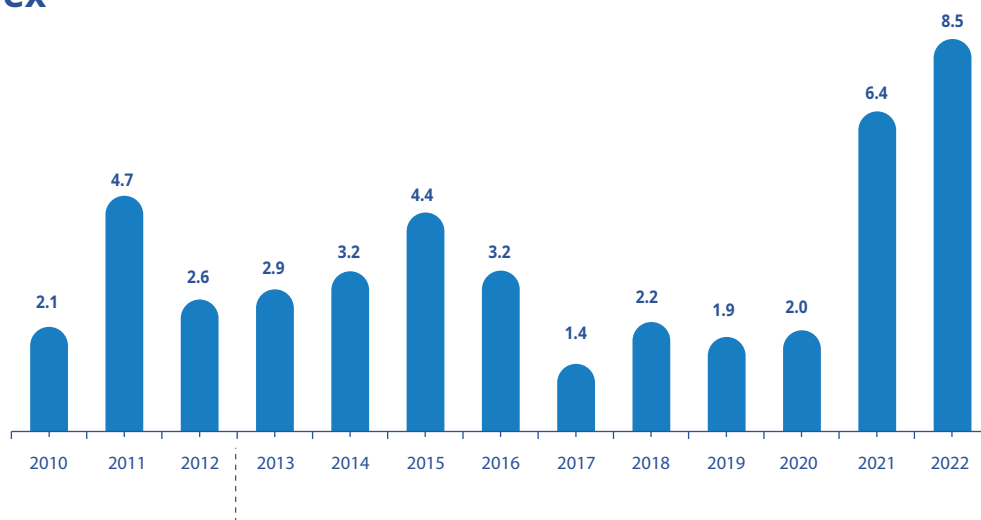
GDP

Net International Reserves (NIR)

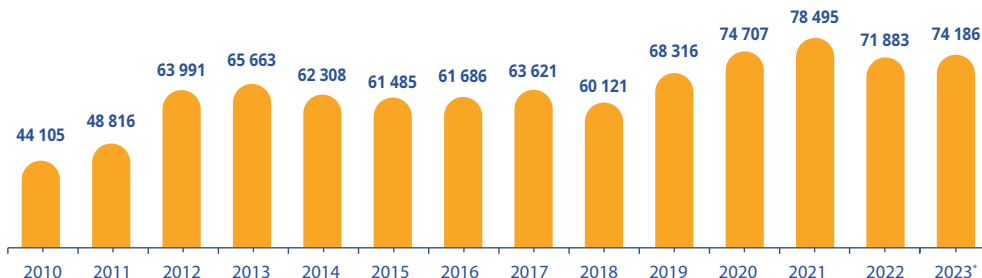
Millions of US Dollars

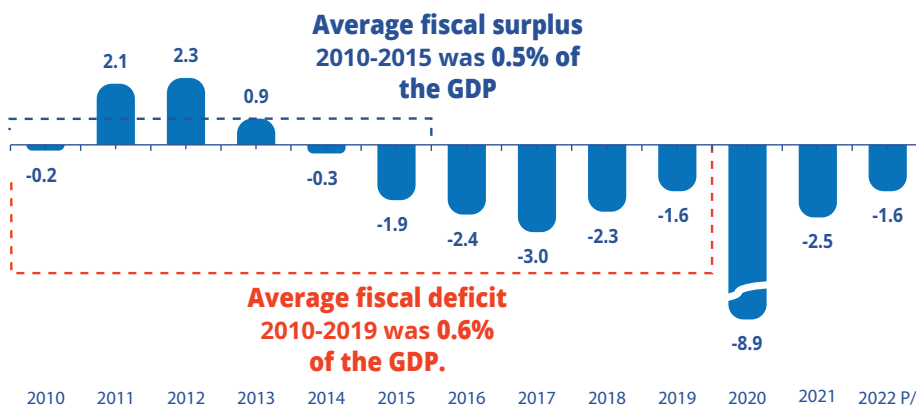

Fiscal deficit of the year 2022 was **1.6%** of the GDP.



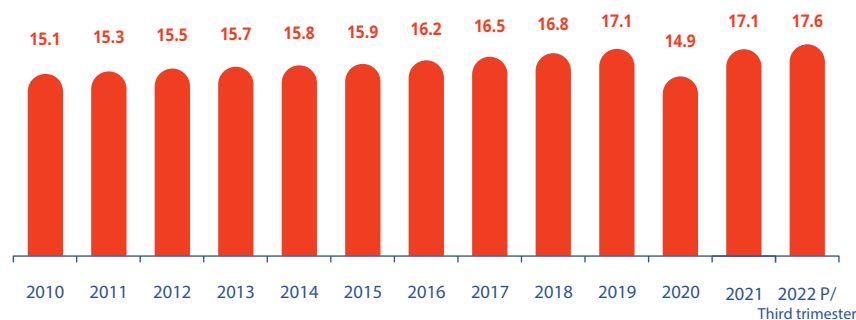

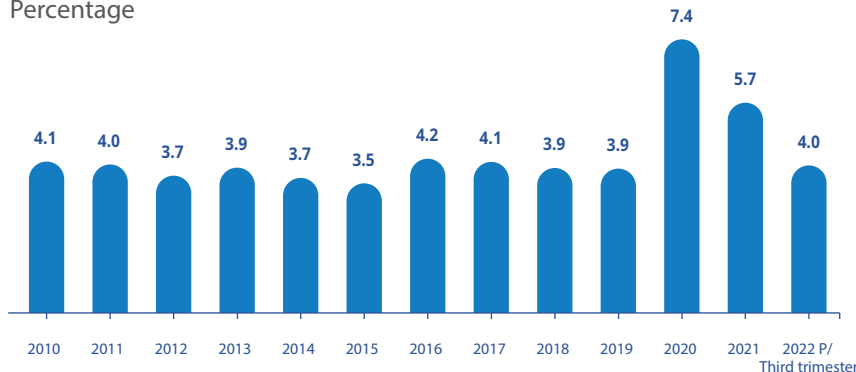

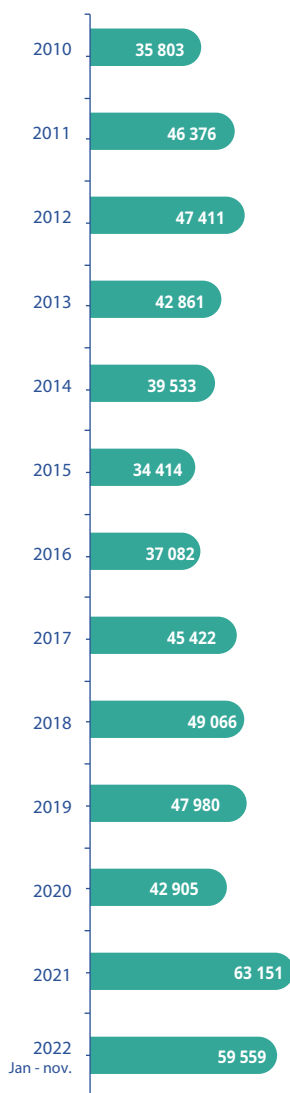

Millions of US Dollars



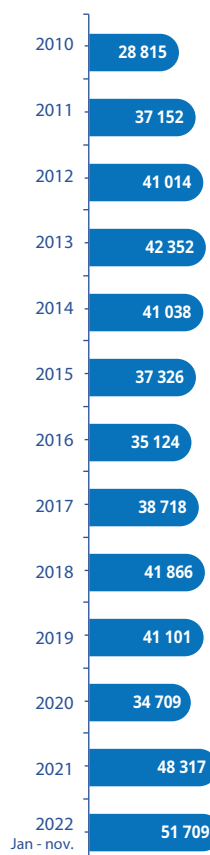

In the last ten years, Peruvian **exports** grew at an annual average rate of **3.1%**.

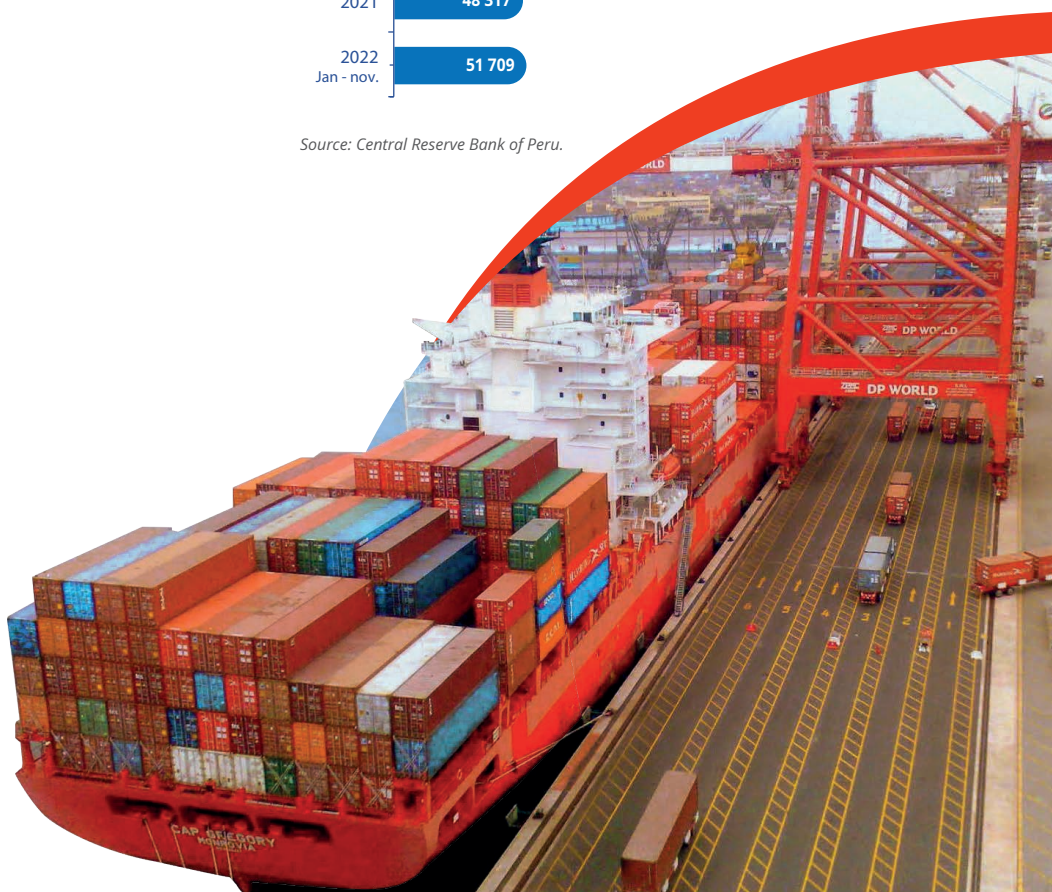
PERU: Imports

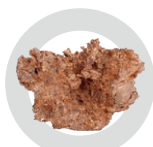

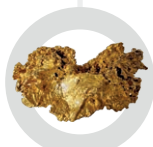

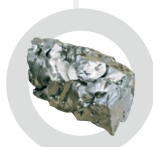

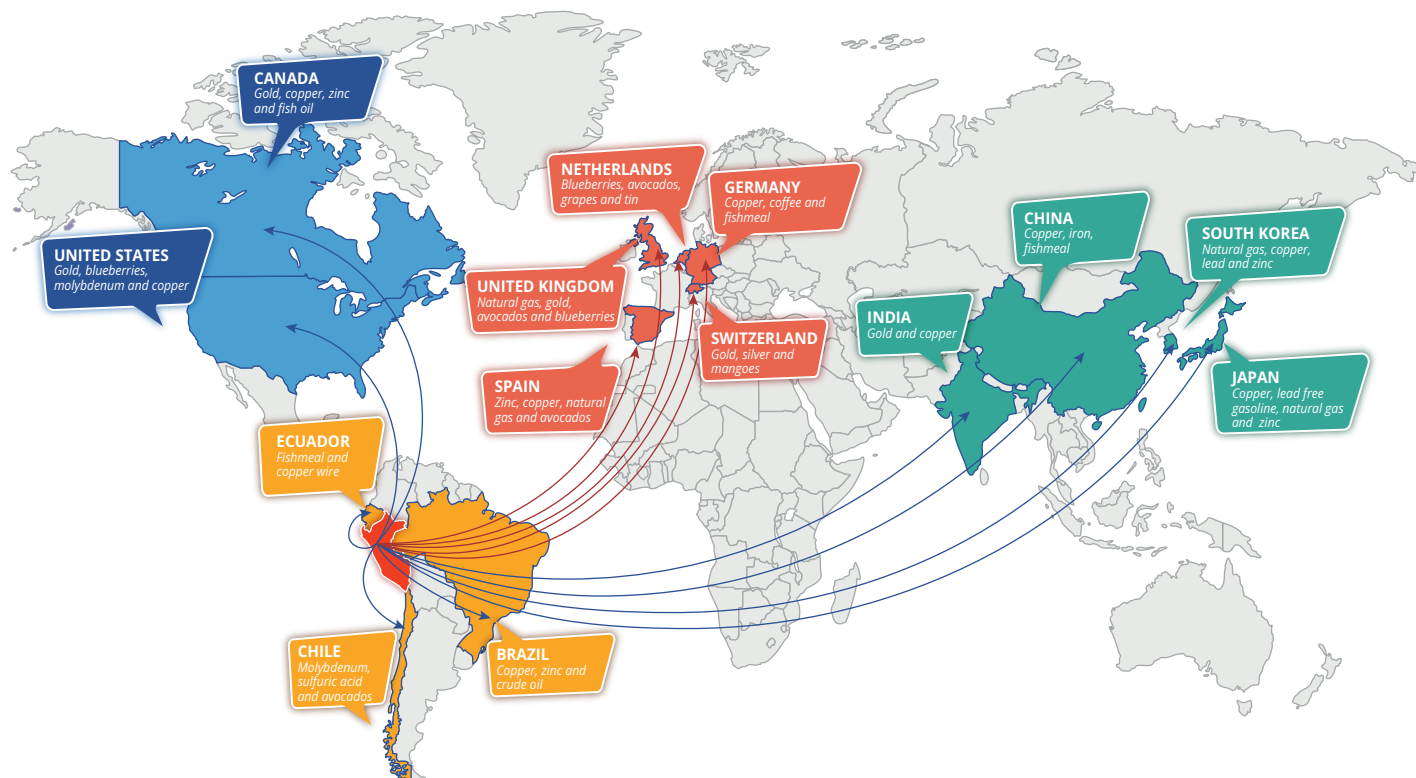
