

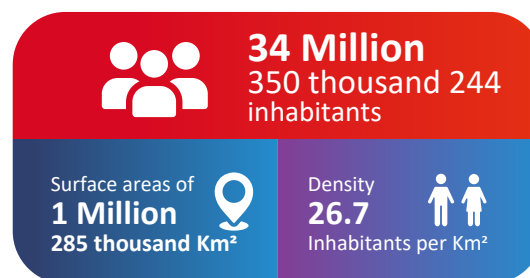
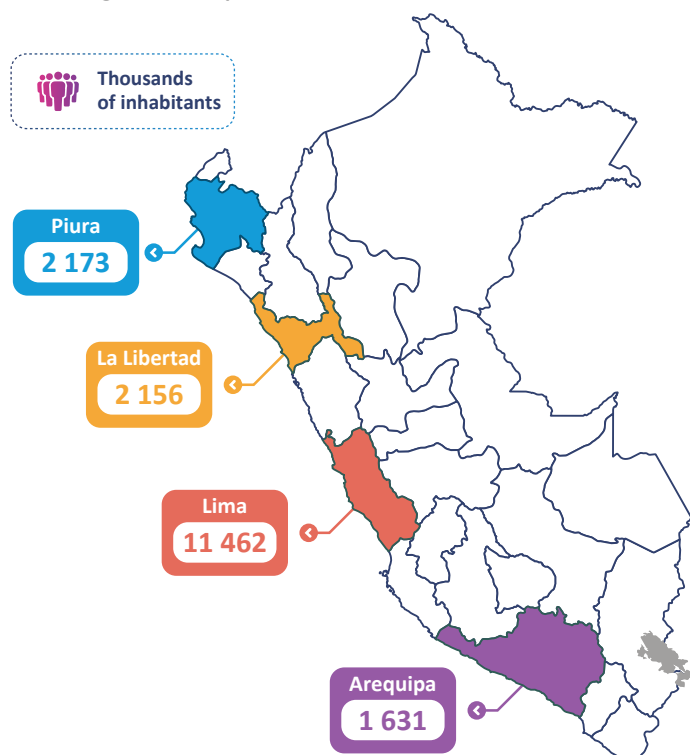

According to main departments



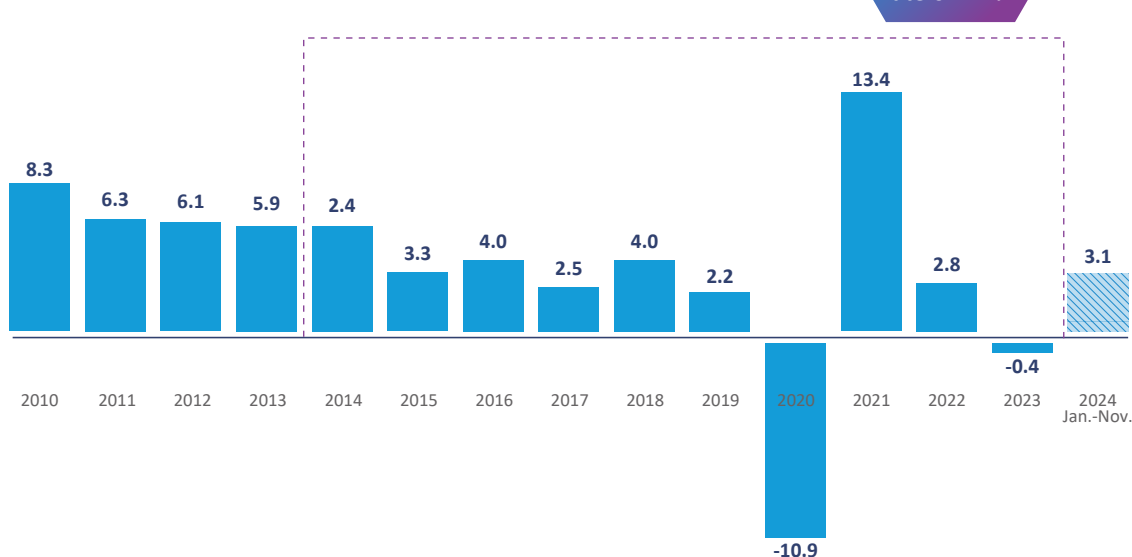
Lima is the most populated department at national level with **11 million 462 thousand inhabitants in 2025**, followed by Piura, La Libertad and Arequipa, among the main ones.

Peru: Gross Domestic Product

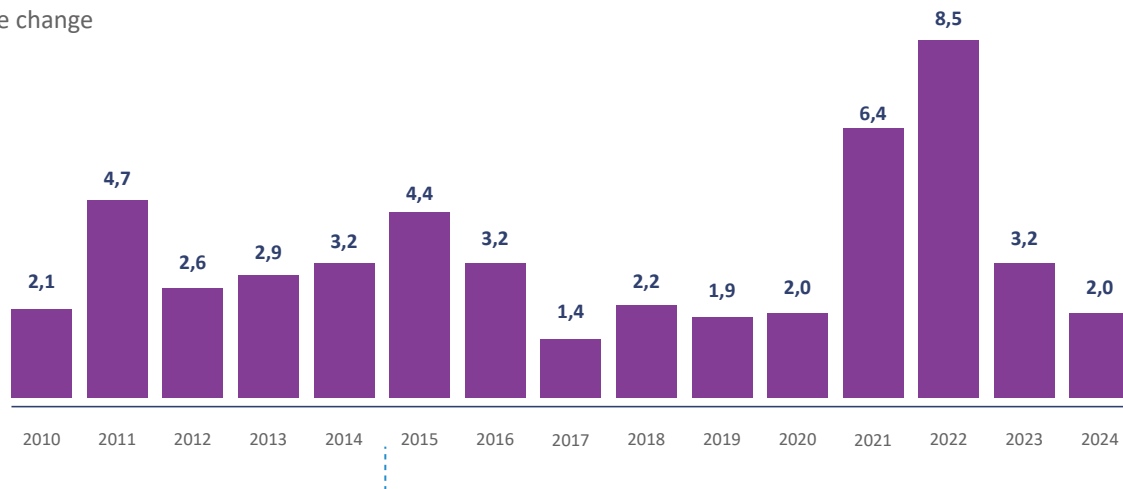
Growth rate

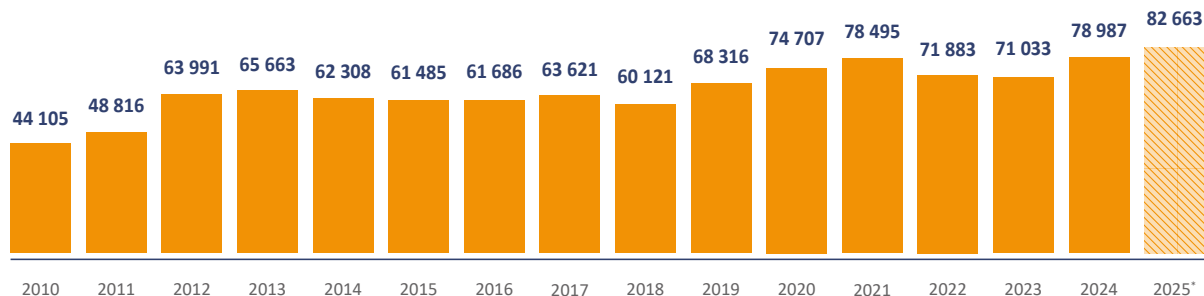

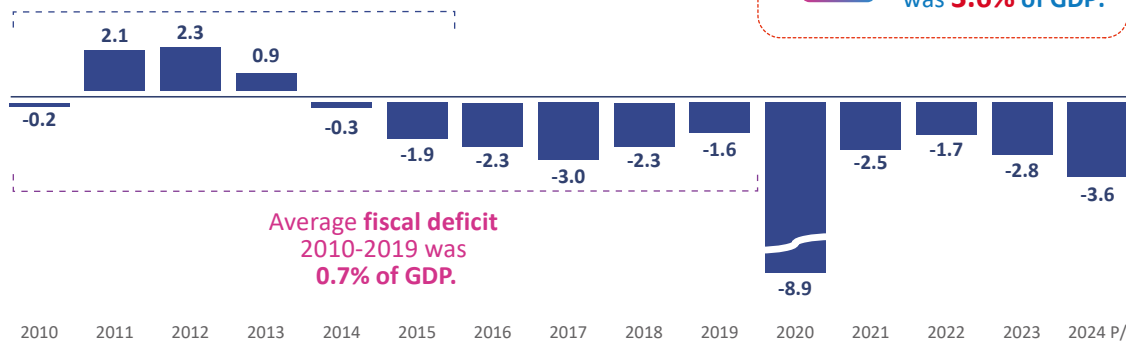

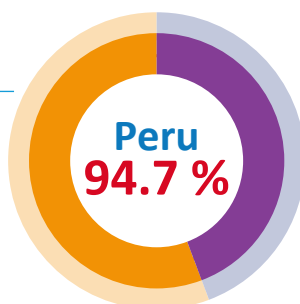


Peru: Employed population, 2024*

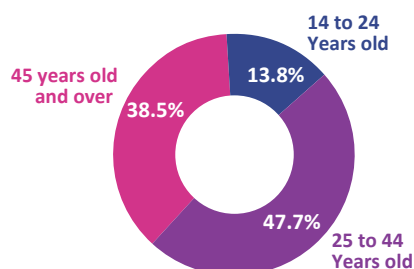
Percentage and percentage distribution

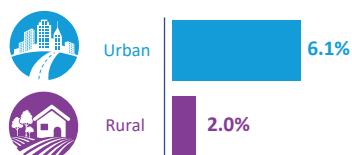

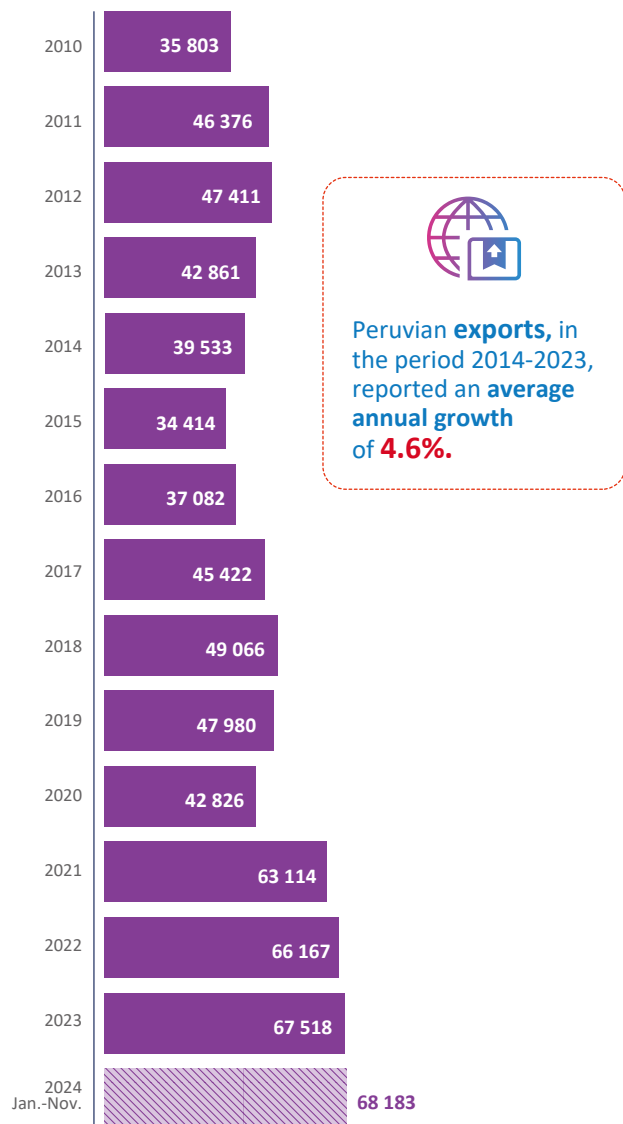

Peru: Exports

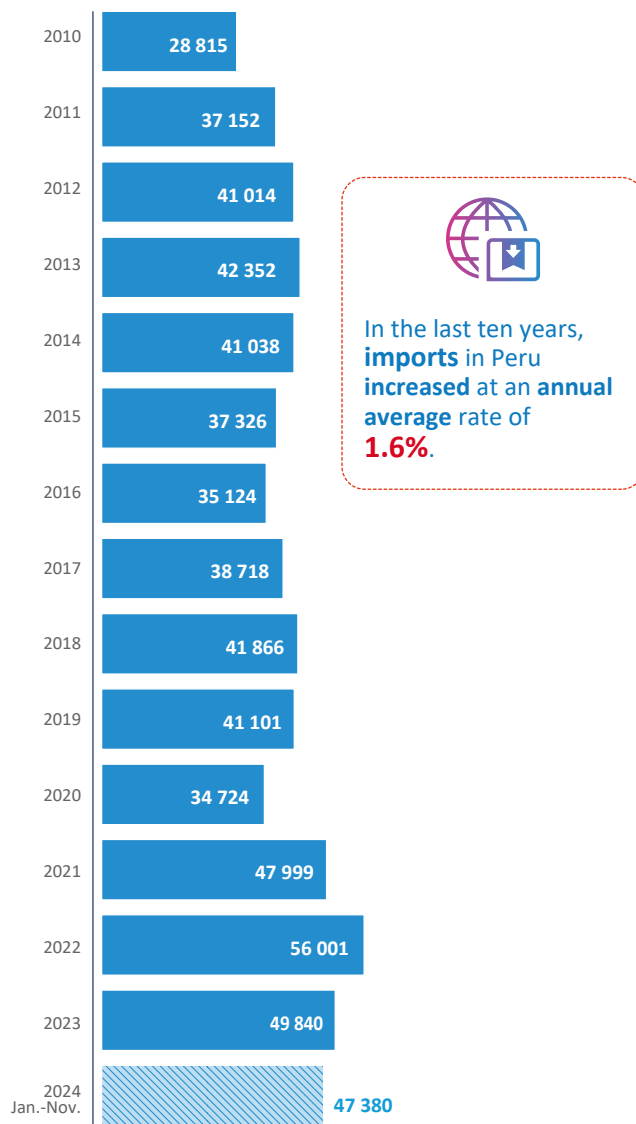

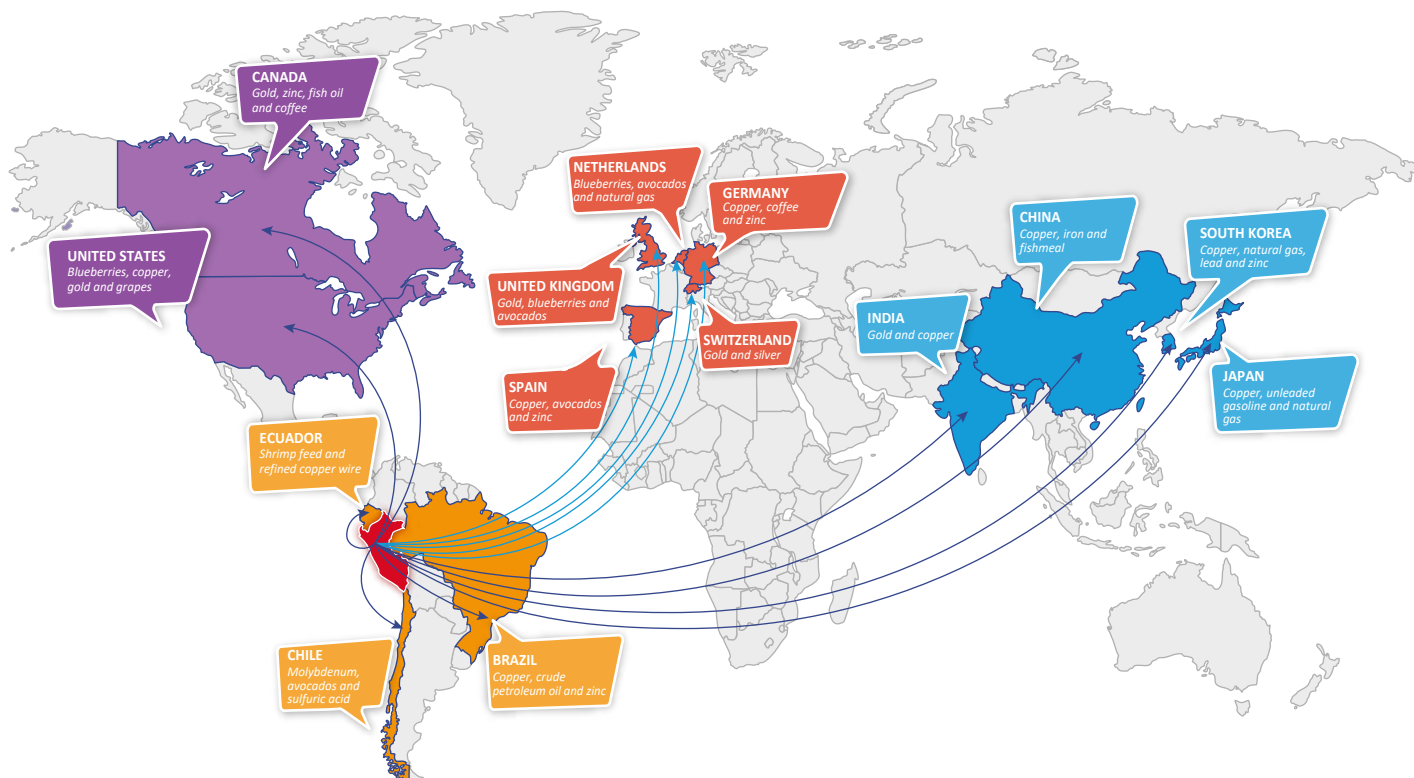
