








Peru: Net International Reserves (NIR) Millions of US\$







Percentage of GDP










Peru: Employed population, 2024*

Percentage and percentage distribution








Peru: Unemployment rate, 2024*




Peru: Exports

Peru: Imports Millions of US\$




In the last ten years, imports in Peru increased at an annual average rate of 1.6%.






Peru: **Main Export Products 2024*** Millions of US\$
