

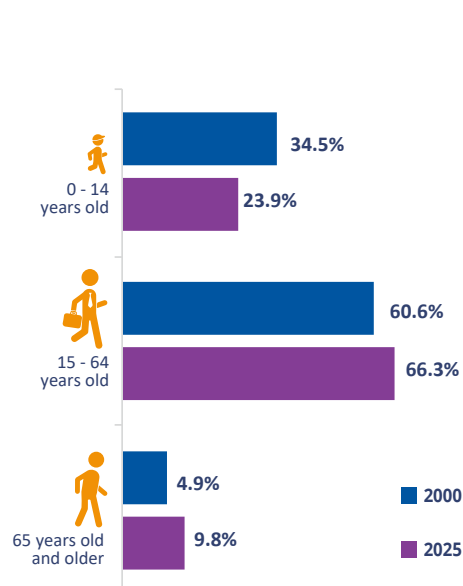

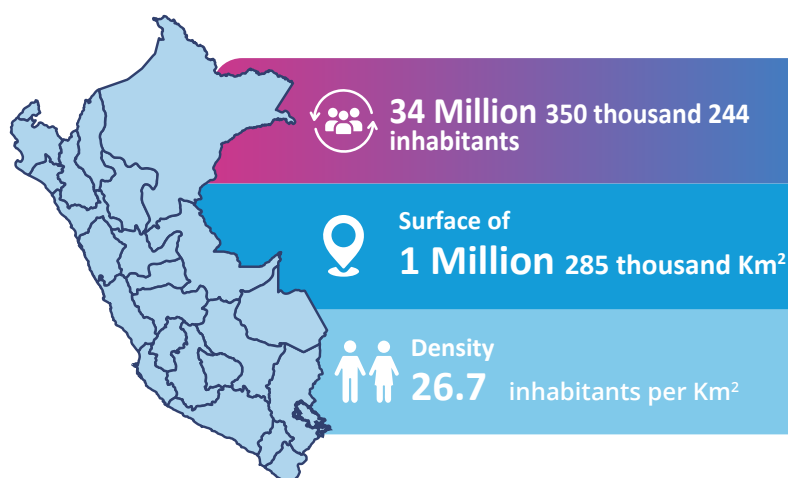

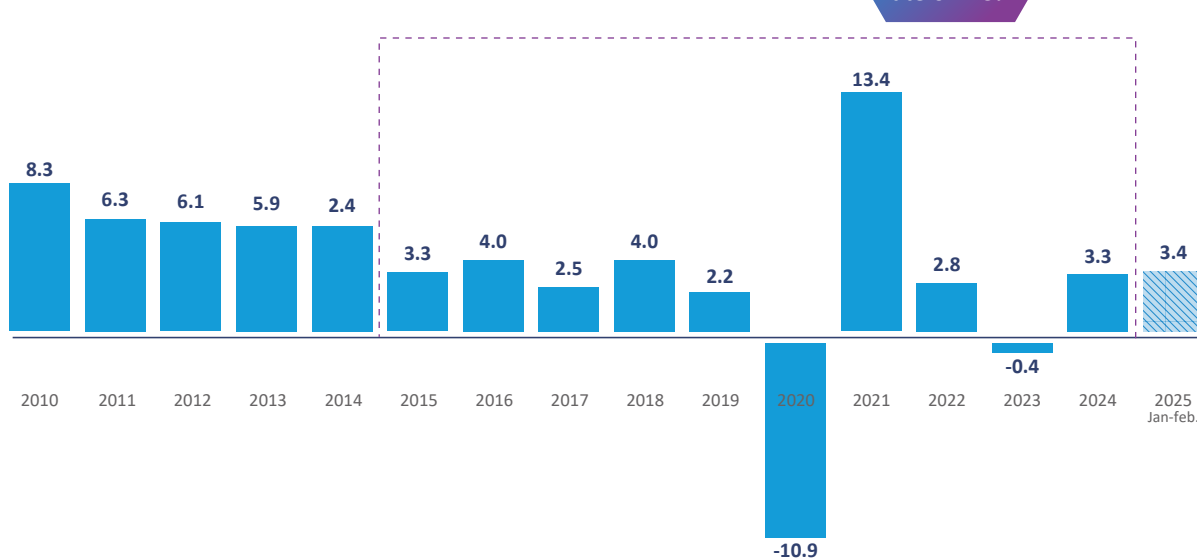
In Peru, **66.3%** of the total population is in the age group of 15 to 64 years old.





Peru: Gross Domestic Product

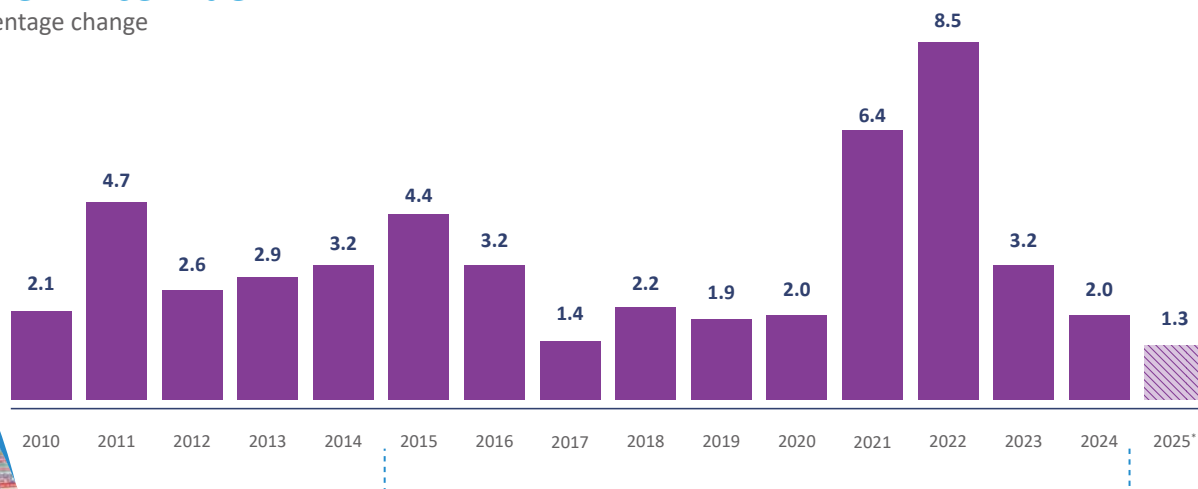
Growth rate

The variation in prices in Metropolitan Lima in the decade 2015-2024 was of 3.5% annual average.



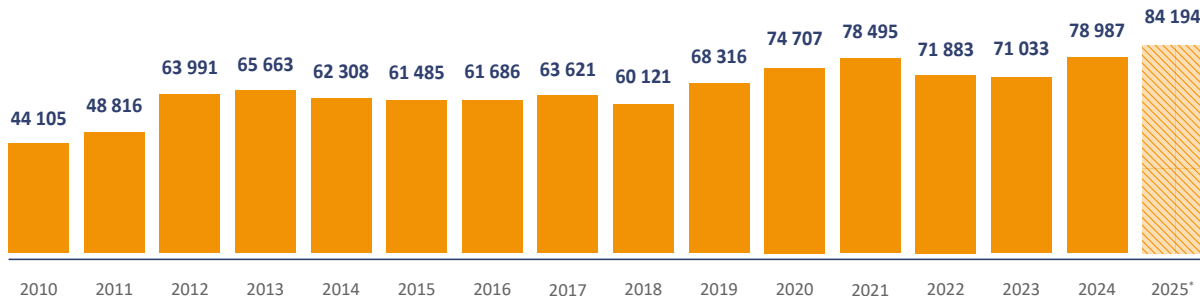
Peru: Net International Reserves (NIR)

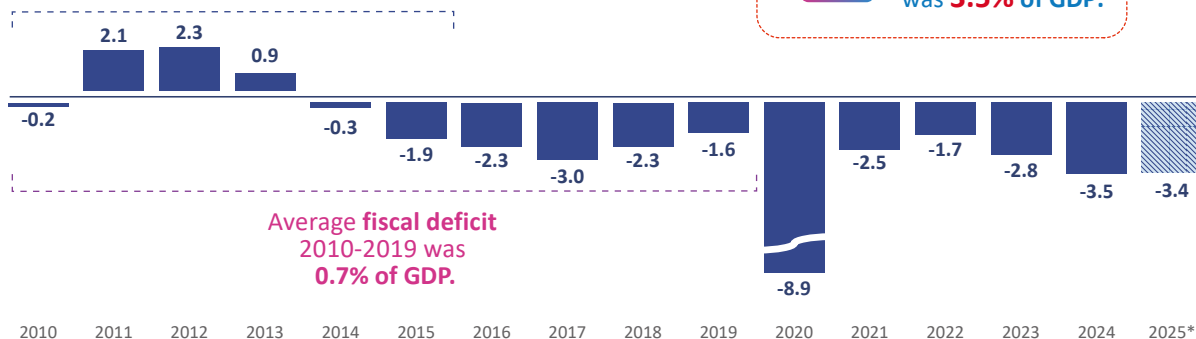

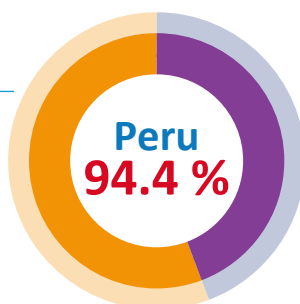


Peru: Employed population, 2024

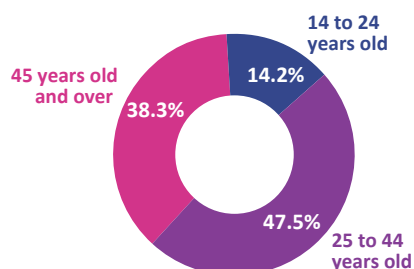

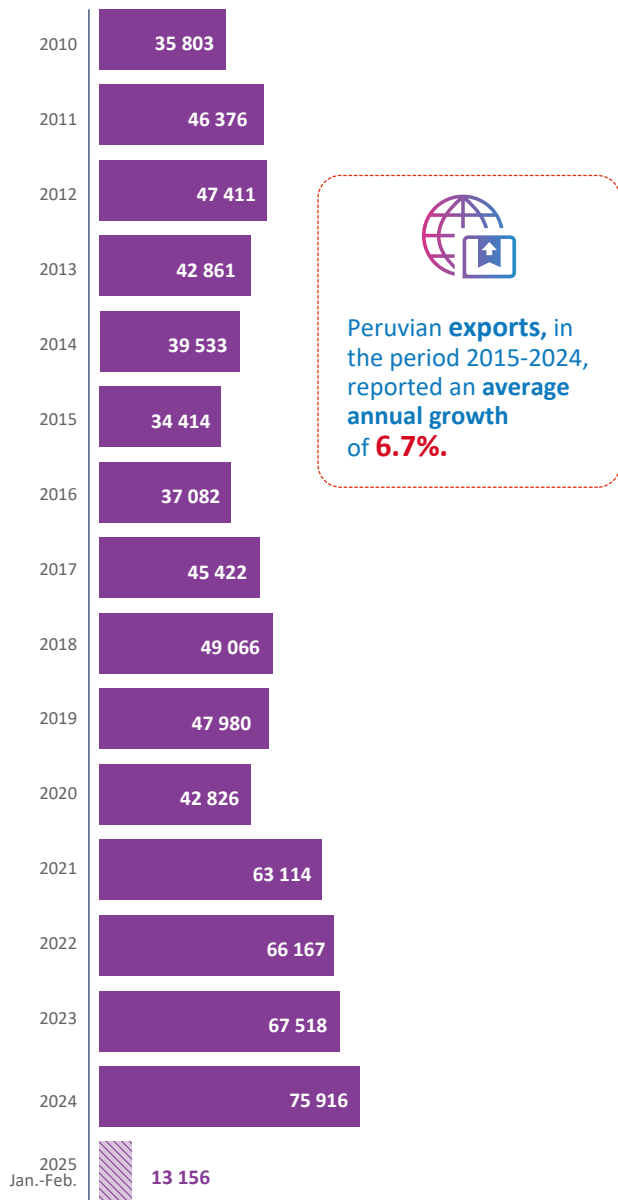

Peru: Exports

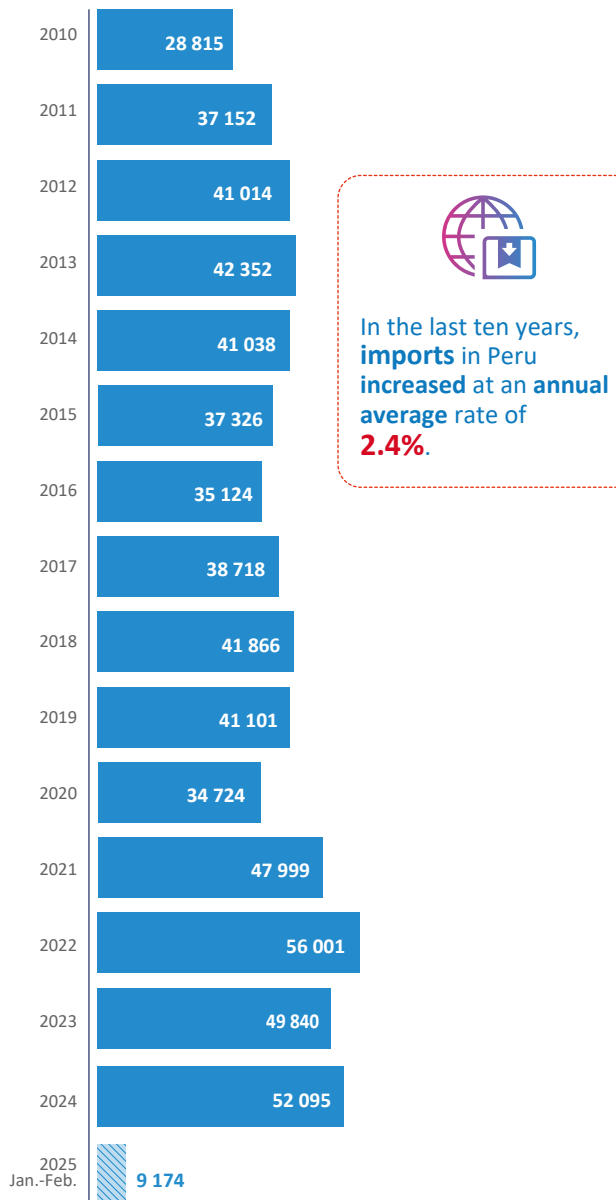

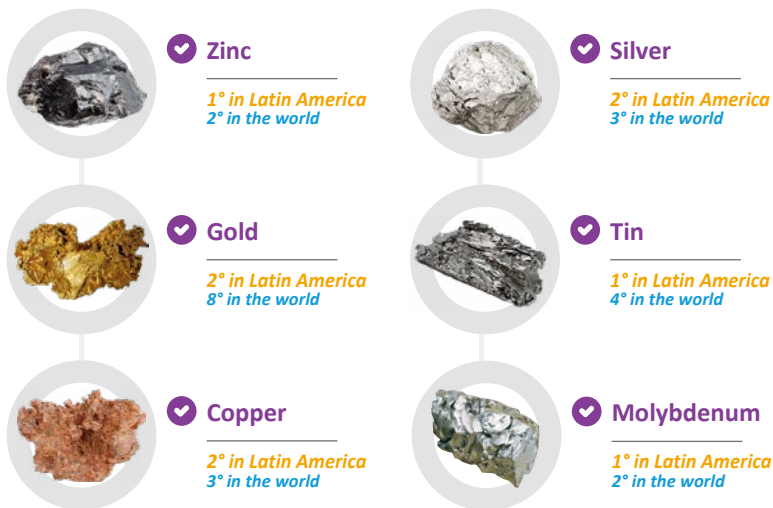




Perú: Main Export Products 2024

Ranking of mining products



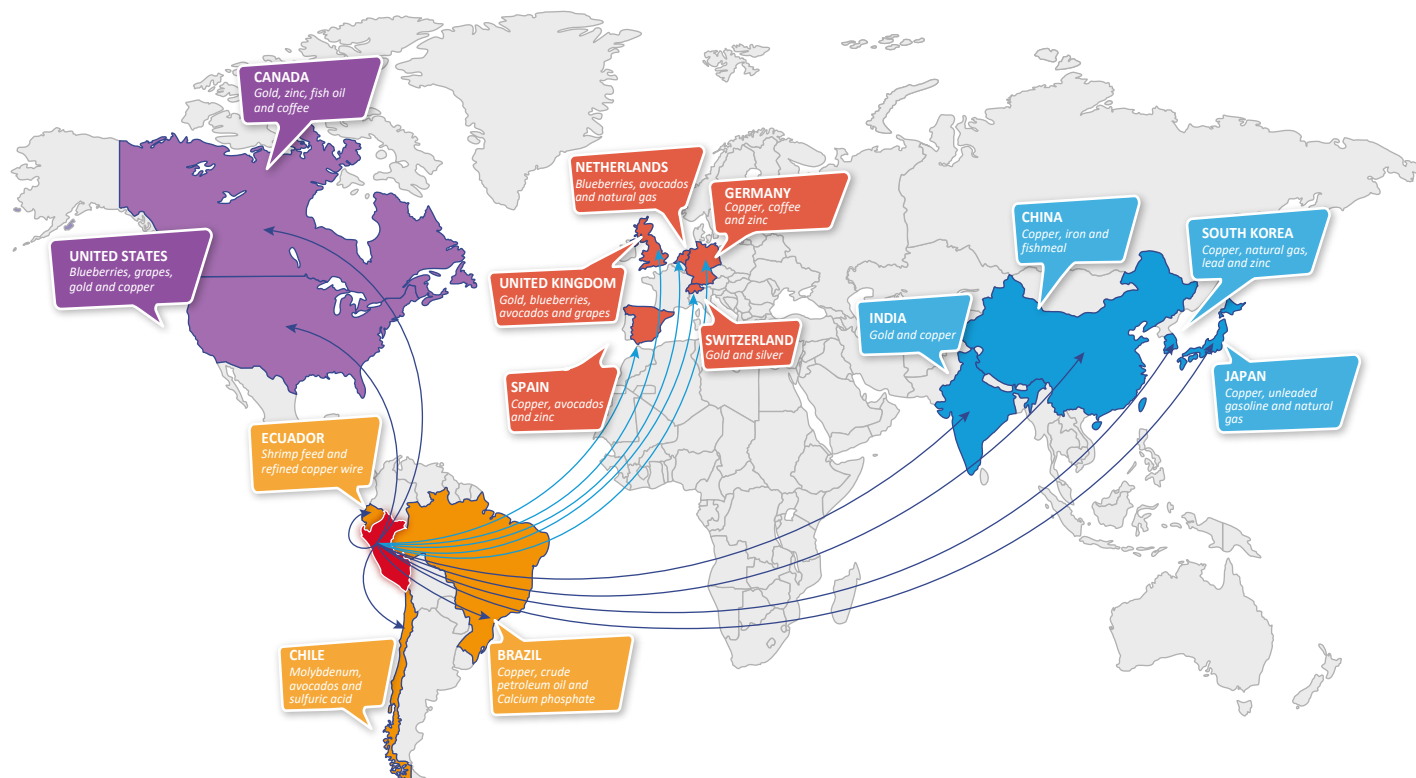
